Top 5 Things You Need to Know

1 The Service Experience

Our services are centered around a teaching from the Bible, usually a Bible story. Our primary goal is to explore the weekly Bible story and show how that passage connects to the Good News of Jesus. No matter what part of the Bible we are starting at that week, we always get to Jesus!

2 We Have Fun

An Elementary child is all about having fun, and we design our services for kids to have a blast! Each week we have a variety of segments like songs, illustrations, stories, and games. Throughout their time together, they will compete, play, laugh, and get to know other kids. Most importantly, each week, kids will get to gather together in a small group.

3 Small Groups

Throughout the service experience, our elementary kids are organized into small groups, usually arranged by group and gender. This allows the small group leader to really get to know their group of five to ten kids. Here, the leader can engage their interests to promote a personal and interested God. The variety of segments coming from the front of the room are all designed to set up small group interactions. We aim for small group to be the most impactful part of the elementary service experience.

4 Wellness

We care about the health of your child and the other kids too! Therefore, we ask that all kids who are experiencing a fever of 99.8 or above, vomiting, or have started taking an antibiotic within the last 24 hours not come to class on that day. Additionally, we thoroughly clean and disinfect all classroom items regularly.

5 Take It Home

We believe that the best and most clear image of the real Jesus a child can see should be in their home. Each week we provide resources to cue parents on what story we covered, what teaching emphasis was highlighted, and what discussion was started in small group so that parents can continue the conversation at home with their kids.
